Short Written Summary of Overall Pest Management for the Year:

Dayton School District has continued to use Monitoring Boxes (mouse and insect) in all areas most likely to be problem areas. Sugar ants were the main problem. We continue to educate teachers on keeping rooms clean of food and packaging food properly.

Dayton School District contracts with C and D Landscape Company, an approved pesticide applicator, for lawn maintenance which includes weed control and fertilization. A record of applications is included in report.

Rats were sighted by the propane tanks in the bushes. Rats were trapped, and there have been no further sightings. No apparent entry into any school building.
