

## Dayton School District Immunization and Exemption Rates

2016-2017

The Oregon Health Authority states that at least 95% of children should be immunized for community protection, though the percentage varies by disease. When 95% of children are vaccinated in a school, this significantly reduces the chance of spreading the disease among vulnerable individuals.
